The mental and physical challenge to cycle nearly 700 km in less than a week is something the participating cyclists will have to master by themselves, but the feeling of achievement at the end of the ride, the friendships formed and the memories will reward for all the pain and suffering. To master the challenge of raising funds for the wonderful cause that <u>EAI</u> represents, we all need your help. Our ride will end on Saturday, February 18 at the Baan Fah Sighy Children Home, which is located approximately 100km south of Chiang Mai. This last day ride goes through some beautiful parts of North Thailand and is easy and flat. The arrival at Baan Fah Sighy marks the official end of CWC 2017 and spending time with the children of Baah Fah Sighy will a very special experience. We thought that it would be nice to be able to celebrate this special occasion together with our friends, family, sponsors and those that would like to ride the whole tour, but are prevented from it due to time or other constraints. Hence we have decided to offer a special package that would allow people to join the visit to Baan Fah Sighy on February 18. This special package has a cycling and a van option and also includes the accommodation, lunch at the children home and the celebration dinner. I will distribute details soon in a separate mailing and our Facebook page.

On February 19, the day after our tour officially ends, we will take the children of Baan Fah Sighy for an excursion to the Chiang Mai Zoo.
